A Year of Growth in Support for Our Neighbors

In 2024, the need for food assistance surged to levels we haven't seen in years. In just two years, our food budget skyrocketed by **1,100**%, as we worked to keep our shelves stocked and meet the demand. This increase meant we provided **240**% **more food orders** compared to 2022, as our neighbors' faced challenges. Many are struggling to cover basic bills, and with no room left in their budgets for food, we've been here to help.

Anticipating a higher demand in 2024, we began reaching out to potential funders to help cover the costs. We're incredibly grateful to the organizations that stepped up to make this possible: **Advisors Excel**, **Evergy Foundation, Frontier Farm Credit, PrairieBand Potawatomi Nation, EFSP**, **Bishop's Storehouse**, and private family foundations. Their generosity allowed us to continue supporting our community. In total, **\$84,500** was spent on food, enabling us to distribute **167,833 pounds** of food to those in need in 2024.

A Hand Up, Not Just a Handout

Watching the stress lift from the faces of those we help is the most rewarding part of our work. Providing a little extra support at a critical time makes a huge difference in people's lives, and the relief it brings is the gratitude we cherish most.

As we move forward in 2025, we remain committed to helping our neighbors through the toughest of times. With your continued support, we will ensure that no one in our community must face hardship alone.

Celebrating 60 Years of Neighbors Helping Neighbors

In 2026, Doorstep will proudly celebrate **60 years** of serving our community! Over the next year, we'll be hosting a series of events leading up to our **60th Anniversary celebration**, culminating in the **Walk/5K Fun Run in June 2026**.

It all started 59 years ago when **six churches in central Topeka** came together to support their neighbors in need—literally helping people on their doorsteps. Since then, our mission has expanded, but the heart of our work remains the same: helping those in need with dignity, compassion, and a hand-up.

Today, Doorstep is powered by **55 Mission Members** who unite to assist our neighbors with basic needs and empower them to overcome life's challenges. We are proud to be a part of a legacy that's all about **Neighbors Helping Neighbors**.


A total of \$388,459 was spent on emergency services. We distributed 167,833 pounds of food & \$178,805 worth of clothing & household items to our neighbors in need.

Christmas Adoption Project

Thank you to everyone who donated gifts, time, and/or money to Doorstep's Christmas Project in 2024! We provided food, gifts, blankets, school supplies, health kits, ice cream, laundry detergent, wrapping paper and gift cards to 260 households, making the holidays brighter for 824 individuals!

Countless hours are spent in preparation for and during distribution week when it becomes all hands on deck to provide Christmas for our neighbors who cannot provide it themselves. We had at least 115 volunteers here working just for distribution! We spent nearly \$40,500 on food, gifts, hygiene items, school supplies and gift cards! **Cathy Butler**, Christmas Project Chair, said her goal was to get each individual one thing from their 'Wish List', and we did! However, Doorstep could not have provided Christmas for 824 of our neighbors without our wonderful donors, Mission Members, and volunteers!
